Overview

Thank You for signing up for the 10th Annual Flurry Fest Doubles Tournament on Saturday (February 10)!

- Please carefully read the first 2 pages for rules/guidelines, pages 3-4 to find your division, and your appropriate division page for your playing times.
 - We are using two different facilities. All of your matches will be played at the same facility.
 - Elite Division will be @ Mandan Tennis Center (MTC) 520 16th St NE Mandan
 - All other divisions will be @ Capital Racquet and Fitness Center (CRFC) 3200 N 10th St Bismarck
- We strongly encourage <u>checking in and being ready to play at least 10-15 minutes before match time</u>. If there is an available court, we will get you started early and keep the tournament flowing.
- Format is best 2 out of 3 sets to 4 games (First to 4 games wins the set and you must win by 2 games)
 - <u>No-ad scoring</u> (The first deuce is gamepoint and receiving team picks the side)
 - Standard 7 point tiebreak will be played at 4 games all to decide the set.
 - A 10 point super tiebreak will be played in lieu of a third set.
 - Regular (No Coman) tiebreaks will be used to determine the set (7 point) and match (10 point) tiebreaks.
- Warmup may NOT exceed 10 minutes. Please try to shorten the warmup for subsequent matches.
- Breaks on changeovers should NOT exceed 90 seconds. Breaks between sets should NOT exceed 2 minutes.
- Match scoring formats may be altered at the discretion of the tournament officials to ensure all matches are completed within the time limit.

Guidelines

- High standards of conduct, fair play, and good sportsmanship are expected.
- Please be courteous to those playing matches on other courts.
 - If your ball goes on or behind another court, please wait to retrieve it until they are done with their point.
- Players are responsible for their own line calls and scoring. Please be clear in your 'out' calls.
 - Try to work out scoring disputes on the court first before asking for help from tournament officials.
 - A ball that is 99% out is still considered in. (You must be 100% sure to call a ball out).
- It is recommended to announce the score clearly and loudly when serving to avoid any scoring discrepancies.
- Divisions and seeding are based on a combination of rankings, ratings, past tournament performance, matchups, and team preference.
- If you are waiting for your match to start, we encourage you to watch the other matches. The CRFC viewing area can be accessed via a flight of stairs that is located just past court 1 behind the curtain.
 - Family and friends are also encouraged to come watch.

Facilities

- When you enter CRFC, you will find Men's Locker Room straight ahead and Women's Locker Rooms to the left. Drinking fountain, bottle filling station, and vending machines are located in between the locker rooms.
- These are the best places to use the restroom. Unisex bathrooms are located one floor above. When you enter CRFC, the tennis courts can be found by making your first right, going down the long hallway, and through the door.
 - The tournament check-in desk will be on a racquetball court close to the tennis courts (Door #5 or #7).
- If you would like to practice at CRFC, you can reserve a court on Friday (February 9) from 7am 9pm.
 Court fees are \$12 for Adults and \$9 for Juniors for the first hour (\$1 add-on for each additional half hour).
 - On the morning of the tournament, you may practice for free on the courts from 7 745am.
- If you would like to practice at MTC, you can reserve a court on Friday (February 9) from 9am 4pm.
 Court fees are \$11 per person per hour.

NET-IQUETTE For Spectators (Family & Friends)

Rules

- All spectators must stay off the court.
- Conversation (related to tennis) is not allowed between spectators and the players while on court.
 - Spectators may offer nonspecific encouragement to their players, such as clapping or saying "Nice Shot" or "Good Try."
- There is no coaching allowed during the warmup or match.
 - No hand signals or verbal coaching cues, such as "move your feet", "focus", "toss the ball higher", etc.
- Spectators are prohibited from calling out a score or assisting with line calls while a match is in progress.
- When walking past the tennis courts at CRFC, we have a few asks to limit distractions for the players:
 - Please refrain from lifting, or peeking through or around the curtain
 - Please don't make loud conversation or other noises

Standard of Conduct

- Treat players and spectators with respect at all times.
- We ask all spectators to cheer respectfully. Acknowledge well played tennis. Recognize your player's well played shot, as well as the opponent's.
 - No cheering for an unforced error or double fault by your player's opponent.
 - No cheering loudly or aggressively to the point of distraction
- All players and spectators shall conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner both on and off the court.

Spectators have a responsibility to set a positive example for good sportsmanship to the players by following these rules of Tennis "Net-iquette".





 - Each team is guaranteed at least 2 matches. Half will play 2 and half will play 3.


