Guidelines
Players new to league tennis must self-rate using the USTA's on-line questionnaire and NTRP (National Tennis Rating Program) guidelines. The questionnaire will prompt the players to describe their playing background history and will sugest a minimum rating it is the players' responsibility to select the rating that best the players' responsibity to select the rating thes describes their playing ability. An on-line appeal can be submitted if players disagree with the suggested minimum rating. Watch the USTA video about how to Self-Rate


Players self-rate by placing their cursor over USTA League and then click on the Self-Rate link below Find NTRP Rating Info (See above circled in red) or when registering for a team for the first time.

## NTRP Appeals

Players may appeal their computer rating at any time. There are three types of appeals: Self-rate Appeals, Automated Appeals and Medical Appeals. Details regarding the appeal process can be found on the USTA website.

> Team Management

Create Match Lineups and Practice Lineups, Email all team players. This program allows your players to indicate heir availability for each of the matches. Click on line-up to select players for each match.

Match Schedule

Match Schedule will identify Home matches. In your area if you are required to make court reservations for home matches, do so quickly.
Player Roster

With the Player Roster, the captain can make sure each player is registered, and can see how match matches each player has played as the season progresses.

Use the Captain's Report to contact the opposing captain before each match to verify details about each match
Team Summary

Team Standings will show you Wins Losses and Games Won \%. TennisLink calculates which team is in 1st place etc., and the actual wins and losses.
